FIRE RECRUIT - 1463

DEFINITION:

Under immediate supervision, to attend the Fire Academy in preparation for a fire fighting career; and to perform related work.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:

Fire Recruit is the entry-level class in the Fire Fighter series. Upon successful completion of the Fire Academy, Recruits are promoted to Fire Fighter I.

*** EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:**

- Attends a 16-week paid Fire Academy, which includes coursework and practice in fire prevention and suppression, emergency medical training, and State and local laws.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Please note: the minimum qualifications stated below are a guide for determining the education, training, experience, special skills, and/or license which may be required for employment in the class. These are re-evaluated each time the position is opened for recruitment. 18 years of age. Graduation from high school, or passage of the California High School Proficiency Examination (CHSPE) or General Education Development (GED) examination. A valid Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certification is required at the time of hire. Possession of all the following valid certificates: Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Certificate or a Paramedic License issued only by the State of California or by the National Registry (NREMT-Basic) or by an EMT or Paramedic certifying agency approved by the State of California; and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Card (Healthcare Provider/BLS Provider equivalent or higher). Possession of a valid California Class C Driver's License.
