#### ITEM - 4: **DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Bill Anderson reported they released a draft of the Otay Mesa Community Plan Update to date for public review. The plan can be found at <u>www.sandiego.gov/planning</u> and then you will need to go to Otay Mesa page and you will see a link to the update. The plan will be out for public review for a few months and we are planning on having a Planning Commission workshop later this spring. We will also be discussing the plan with the Otay Mesa Community Planning group at their next subsequent meeting and several meetings. Their next meeting is on Wednesday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, at 3:00 pm at the Otay Mesa/Nestor Library located at 3003 Coronado Avenue. We are now entering the CEQA phase of the Plan Update process and hopefully this calendar year or more likely the early part of next calendar year the plan will becoming forward for the hearing.

The Barrio Logan Community Plan Update draft is being distributed for internal departmental review of that draft. After we receive those comments we will be able to release that draft for public review and again start the CEQA process for that Plan Update.

We were pleased to announce that the City of San Diego was awarded a \$50,000 grant from Sandag to pursue land development code amendments to support urban agriculture. The grant will allow DSD and CPCI to look beyond community gardens to address broader urban agriculture topics and issues...

The grant is a part of the County of San Diego communities putting preventions to work program which is funded by the Federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention...the work will begin in May. Last night we had a meeting of the Greater Golden Hill Community Update Advisory Committee. At the meeting we reviewed our approach for historic districts and conservation areas and reviewed input received to date at the meetings and at the charrette in the fall...

Grantville on Monday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, at 6:00 pm there will be a meeting of the Grantville stakeholders committee at the Mission Valley Church of the Nazarene 4750 Mission Gorge Place. The meeting will focus on Navajo Community Park opportunities as well as a draft zoning program for Grantville.

The next meeting of the San Ysidro Community Plan Update Advisory Committee will be on Wednesday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, at 6:00 pm at Willow Elementary at 226 Willow Rd. in San Ysidro. The meeting will focus on urban design and community character.
