Prior to recording a final map, the subdivider shall provide an independent evaluation prepared in accordance with the state of California business & professions code including section 7195) of the existing conditions of the building to the satisfaction of the city manager. This information shall include, but not be limited to: the structural integrity; mechanical; electrical; and plumbing systems of the building. The applicant shall provide proof of compliance or other means to assure any recommendations to repair or replace those systems to the satisfaction of the city.
