PLACE NOISE SENSORS ON THE HILLSIDE ADJACENT TO THE HOMES ON PROSPERITY LANE AND DEFIANCE WAY. THESE SENSORS WILL BE MONITORED BY THE MANAGEMENT OFFICE AND WILL INFORM MANGEMENT IF THE NOISE EXCEEDS LEVELS DEEMED ACCEPTABLE BY THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.
