ITEM - 4: **DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Bill Anderson gave an update on the Community Plan updates. The Barrio Logan staff and the consulting team are conducting a detailed transportation analysis of the scenarios looking at overall transportation impacts and also truck impacts specifically because that is a major issue in the community as well as the air quality impacts. This will generate data to assist further refining the land use scenarios and will be presented to the Barrio Logan Stakeholders committee in August for further consideration and refinement of those scenarios. After that point we expect to begin the CEQA process and that will take us to probably the last third of the plan update process.

Uptown/North Park/Golden Hill: The public outreach consulting contract was approved by the City Council on Tuesday. Once the notice to proceed is issued we will be meeting with the consultant to put together our public outreach strategy and refine it. We are currently collecting in-house base information that we need for the plan updates. We have come to an understanding on what the stakeholder groups will look like in three different communities, the Community Planning Groups in each of those Communities. We are looking forward to kicking off the communities participation part of the process probably this fall, September most likely.

Otay Mesa – the water supply accessment is our last major hurdle and it's the critical path so we need to get a water supply accessment from two water districts, our own Water Dept. and the Otay Water District. That will probably add 90 days to the process. From there we will issue the Draft EIR. The plan will be issued before that time. We anticipate, given

the noticing procedures, getting the draft responding to the draft comments. We probably will not have hearings until December/January for Planning Commission.

Grantville: There will be no meeting in June. The next meeting is July 13th at the Mission Valley Church of the Nazarene located at 4750 Mission Gorge Place.

Last night we had a very nice public workshop on the bicycle master plan. We are working on a Citywide Bicycle Master Plan and that was held at the Hall of Champions and it was well attended.
