ITEM - 4: **DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Bill Anderson reports the budget has been approved and signed. It includes funding to begin the community plan update for Southeastern San Diego/Encanto/Skyline/Paradise Hills combined with other money that we have from Sandag grant and possibly from redevelopment. It also included money to begin the community plan update for Mission Valley, which will be starting this coming fiscal year.

The San Diego Housing Federation gave an award to one of our three development projects, Gateway Project/Barrio Logan Affordable Housing Project.

LU&H considered two items: one was a building permit timeline extension to help provide relief to projects that have been caught up in the recession to give some relief for a period of time until the recession passes so they wouldn't have to re-apply as they are approaching the end of their deadline. Also, to defer FBA fees from building permits until final inspection, that would be a sunset of two years on the FBA fees and then the ability to defer would apply to this and affordable housing in the future and it also included an automatic cost escalator as part of the fee program which we current don't have.

The request for the workshop on Public Utility design and location is coming forth. Staff is working on it. We are checking the calendar for coordination with the other departments that would be involved in the workshop to see if we can do it before the August recess or afterwards.

Regarding item #9, Commissioner Griswold asked staff to provide a map of the purple pipe to help avoid delays... wants to see where we are at currently and what is proposed to be added to it for the next year or the next few years.

Commissioner Otsuji asked Bill Anderson if there was any progress made in regards to the Park Master Plan in getting funding and requested an update on this Plan.

Bill Anderson replied, because of the budget situation some choices had to be made and so that was not included in the FY10 budget. We proposed it in the following year budget to the Mayor and Council and they will be working on it.
