Bill Anderson reported on the City Council approving the acceptance of a \$500,000 Federal Grant from Fish and Wildlife for preparation of a vernal pool habitat conservation plan. MSCP staff will be working with Stakeholders, wildlife agencies and property owners during the next two years to prepare a citywide plan for the conversation of habitat that supports seven sensitive vernal pool plans and animal species. In about two years we will have that plan in place...and address some of the concerns about land development in areas that have vernal pools.

This Saturday we will be holding our first Uptown/North Park/Golden Hill cluster workshop from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the Hall of Champions in Balboa Park at 2131 Pan American Plaza. Our urban design and historic resource staff and consultants will review the existing urban forum in the three communities, give an overview of historic resources and relay best practices regarding urban design. There will also be a community exercise to discuss shared urban forum issues within the communities...We hope to have a good turnout for this event and encourage stakeholders to attend. You are also welcomed to attend just as long as we don't have a Brown Act violation.
