  - A. <u>Group Job 734, Sewer Main Replacement Project</u> Project is in the area bounded on the north and south by Webster Avenue and Z Street; on the east and west of 36<sup>th</sup> Street and I-15. This project will replace and realign approximately 3,696 linear feet of existing concrete pipe and vitrified clay sewer mains. New curb ramps will be constructed where needed, and the impacted streets will be resurfaced (overlay and/or slurry sealed).
